

Travelling to Loretto

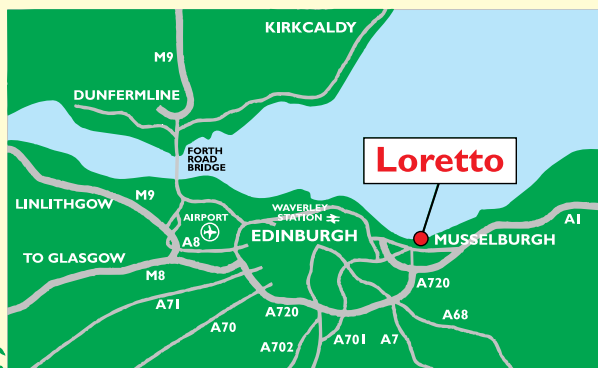
By Air: Edinburgh airport is within easy reach of Loretto School (20 minutes by car or taxi) and has regular scheduled flights to all parts of the UK and Europe. The Amsterdam link is particularly convenient.

By Rail: Rail users may travel to Edinburgh Waverley Station (20 minutes by taxi) from Loretto, which is a mainline station with regular service connections to other major stations.

By Road: Situated on the southern shore of the Firth of Forth and convenient to the M8 motorway, Musselburgh can be easily reached from all parts of Scotland and the UK.

From the M8 (South and West) or M9 (North) look for the A720 (Edinburgh Bypass) heading south: Follow the Bypass towards North Berwick and take the Musselburgh exit at the junction with the A1. From this point follow the signs to the Race Course and Musselburgh Old Links. The Senior School is located at the eastern end of the High Street (A199) adjacent to the Race Course entrance.

From the A1 (South) take the Musselburgh Exit: Follow the signs to the Race Course, the entrance to the Senior School is adjacent to the Race Course entrance. The Junior School is located on the western bank of the River Esk. Follow the High Street (A199) in the direction of Portobello and Edinburgh, turn right at the Brunton Hall. This road curves to the right and the entrance to the Junior School is on your left as you approach the river.



On Arrival: At the Senior School, visitors should report to the Admissions Office at Schoolhouse.

At the Junior School visitors should report to the School Office at North Esk Lodge.

Loretto Location Guide



Location

Loretto's attractive location combines the secure advantages of a country school with the benefits of being only six miles from the city of Edinburgh. The School's grounds and buildings extend over fifty hectares on the east side of Musselburgh, alongside the River Esk, the Musselburgh Race Course and the town's historic golf links. Trees, lawns and playing fields and sympathetic architecture are important to the ethos of the School and always have been.

The School is set back from the main road, on both sides, through Musselburgh, (A199) heading east out of Edinburgh towards Haddington and North Berwick. Pinkie Drive, where the boys' boarding houses, Astroturf, and golf practice areas are located is on your right, just after the Episcopal Church of St. Peter. Entrance to the Senior School is some 200 metres further on, sharp left, immediately before the turning into Mill Hill and Musselburgh Race Course. The girls' boarding houses are located further down Mill Hill on the right. Entrance to the Junior School (5 minutes away) is at the other end of Musselburgh High Street (A199) going west towards Portobello and Edinburgh. Cross the bridge over the River Esk into Musselburgh's North High Street. Follow the road for about 200 metres and turn right at the Brunton Hall. This road curves to the right and the entrance to the Junior School is on your left as you approach the river.

There are frequent bus services to Edinburgh city centre and the local taxi services are available at all hours.
